Do I Have Household Hazardous Waste?

Household hazardous waste can be found in almost every room of your home. These products, if thrown in the garbage or poured down the drain, can have negative effects on the environment including an impact on groundwater and surface water such as creeks, rivers, and lakes. If you use any of the materials listed below, please dispose of them properly by using the Household Hazardous and Electronic Waste Depot or mobile event (no electronic waste or motor oil at mobile events).



Kitchen

- Cooking oil
- Abrasive powders
- Ammonia-based cleaners
- Disinfectants
- Drain decloggers
- Floor and furniture polish
- Oven cleaners
- Metal cleaners/polish
- Window, glass cleaners



Bathroom

- Aftershave
- Perfumes
- Depilatories
- Hair lotions, dyes
- Medicines
- Nail polish & remover
- Toilet bowl cleaner



Garden Shed

- Fertilizers
- Pesticides

Your Guide to HHEW Depot & Mobile Events

First time coming to our Household Hazardous & Electronic Waste Depot or Mobile Event? Here are some important things to remember:

- ✓ Our HHEW Depot and Mobile Events are equipped for **HOUSEHOLD hazardous waste ONLY**. If you are agricultural, commercial or a business, please call us to discuss disposal options of your hazardous waste.
- ✗ No motor oil or electronic waste is accepted at our mobile events.
- ✓ Electronic waste (e-waste) can be taken to our HHEW Depot (75 Wallbridge Cres, Belleville) or our Recycling Facility (270 West St, Trenton). Motor oil can be taken to our HHEW Depot ONLY.
- ✗ Motor oil (HHEW Depot ONLY) cannot exceed 200L and containers cannot be larger than 20L each.
- ✗ Some containers that are brought to the HHEW Depot cannot be returned (e.g. gas cans).
- ✗ Items we CANNOT take:
 - Smoke Detectors
 - Carbon Monoxide Detectors
 - Anything that contains freon (e.g. air conditioners)
- ✓ Stay in your vehicle. Our trained and professional staff are happy to help!



Everything we collect is either **REUSED**, **RECYCLED**, or **DISPOSED OF SAFELY**



Safely disposing of your hazardous waste through our program helps keep our surface and groundwater clean.

Batteries Dead? Recycle Instead!

Step 1:

Gather up dead, intact household batteries including AA, AAA, C, D, 9V*, 6V*, & button cell batteries* and put inside your own clear re-sealable bag.

Step 2:

Seal the bag of batteries and place them **ON TOP** of your papers blue box on your regular collection day between the dates highlighted below.

*please place a small piece of masking tape on exposed terminals of 9v, 6v, and button cells.



Collection Dates: **APRIL 6th to April 17th, 2020**
